Polk County is currently facing an uptick in forest fires while also experiencing dangerous drought conditions. To make matters worse, the County is facing fiscal restraints, resulting in the Polk County Fire Rescue having to do more with less. Polk County Fire Rescue needs these funds to properly fight this recent increase in forest fires. Currently, less than 20% of Polk County Fire Rescue personnel have access to thermal imaging units. With these funds, they can purchase new thermal imaging units to be placed on each response vehicle.
