I am requesting funding for the University of Central Florida Pathogen Surveillance Laboratory in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the University of Central Florida's College of Medicine, located at 6900 Lake Nona Boulevard, Orlando, Florida 32827.

The funding would be used for purchasing two research instruments: A fully automated genomic sequencing instrument and a high-capacity automated sample preparation instrument.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this laboratory will be a part of an Infectious Disease Initiative, which unites researchers from other universities who work together to understand, predict, survey, and mitigate the threats of infectious pathogens benefitting all U.S. citizens. The Initiative's recent research included mosquito-borne diseases, including Zika.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 272 of title 15, United States Code.
